- We will work with you via e-mail to edit and proof your submission prior to publication.
- Articles should be sent as an attachment
- Related pictures are highly encouraged to be submitted along with your article.
 - Images must fall into one of these categories: [1] your own work—i.e. you took the photograph or have permission to use it; [2] freely licensed; [3] public domain; [4] fair use.
 - Attach images to the same e-mail as your article submission.
 - Include a short (1 sentence) caption of each image.
